 To receive and consider the financial statements of the Company and its controlled entities (collectively the "Group") for the year ended 30 June 2018 and the related Directors' Report, Directors' Declaration and Audit Report.

To consider and, if thought fit, pass the following as ordinary resolutions:

Remuneration Report

To adopt the Remuneration Report on pages 11 and 12 of the Annual Report.
 "That the Remuneration Report for the financial year ended 30 June 2018 (as set out in the 2018 Annual Report on pages 11 and 12) be adopted."

Note: The vote on the proposed resolution in item 2 is advisory only and will not bind the directors or the Company, however, the Board will take the outcome of the vote into consideration when reviewing remuneration practices and policies.

Voting Exclusions on Item 2

Section 250R (4) of the Corporations Act 2001, requires the Company to disregard any votes cast on item 2 (in any capacity) by or on behalf of either a member of the key management personnel, details of whose remuneration are included in the remuneration report; or a closely related party of such a member (together "prohibited persons").

However, the Company will not disregard a vote if:

- The prohibited person does so as a proxy appointed by a person who is entitled to vote by writing that specifies how the proxy is to vote on the proposed resolution; or
- A vote is cast by a Director chairing the Meeting as a proxy for a person entitled to vote and who has given an undirected proxy on the proposed resolution.

Explanatory Notes

These Explanatory Notes form part of the Notice of Meeting and are intended to provide shareholders of the Company with information to assess the merits of the proposed resolutions.

Items 3 - Re-election of a director

Re-election of Anthony J Clark AM as a director

Mr Anthony J Clark AM, is an independent, non-executive director who retires by rotation in accordance with the Company's Constitution. Clauses 108(a) and (c) of the Company's Constitution states that a director will not hold office (without re-election) past the third Annual General Meeting following the director's appointment or three years, whichever is longer. A director who retires or whose office is vacated under the Constitution is eligible for re-election to the Board except as expressly provided in the Constitution. Mr Clark was last re-elected as a director at the 2015 Annual General Meeting.

A profile of Mr Clark is included in the 2018 Annual Report and is as follows:

Mr Anthony J Clark AM, FCA, FAICD.

Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia and Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors.

Independent Non-Executive Director since 2000.

Chairman of the Nominations and Remuneration Committee and Chairman of the Audit and Risk Committee (from December 2014).

Broad experience as a director of listed companies and previously practised as a Chartered Accountant retiring as a partner of KPMG in 1998.

Former directorships include Ramsay Health Care Limited, Telstra Corporation Limited, Amalgamated Holdings Limited (now known as Event Hospitality & Entertainment Limited) and Sphere Minerals Limited.

How to Vote on Items of Business

All your securities will be voted in accordance with your directions.

Appointment of Proxy

Voting 100% of your holding: Direct your proxy how to vote by marking one of the boxes opposite each item of business. If you do not mark a box your proxy may vote or abstain as they choose (to the extent permitted by law). If you mark more than one box on an item your vote will be invalid on that item.

Voting a portion of your holding: Indicate a portion of your voting rights by inserting the percentage or number of securities you wish to vote in the For, Against or Abstain box or boxes. The sum of the votes cast must not exceed your voting entitlement or 100%.

Appointing a second proxy: You are entitled to appoint up to two proxies to attend the meeting and vote on a poll. If you appoint two proxies you must specify the percentage of votes or number of securities for each proxy, otherwise each proxy may exercise half of the votes. When appointing a second proxy write both names and the percentage of votes or number of securities for each in Step 1

A proxy need not be a securityholder of the Company.

Signing Instructions for Postal Forms

Individual: Where the holding is in one name, the securityholder must sign.

Joint Holding: Where the holding is in more than one name, all of the securityholders should sign.

Power of Attorney: If you have not already lodged the Power of Attorney with the registry, please attach a certified photocopy of the Power of Attorney to this form when you return it.

Companies: Where the company has a Sole Director who is also the Sole Company Secretary, this form must be signed by that person. If the company (pursuant to section 204A of the Corporations Act 2001) does not have a Company Secretary, a Sole Director can also sign alone. Otherwise this form must be signed by a Director jointly with either another Director or a Company Secretary. Please sign in the appropriate place to indicate the office held. Delete titles as applicable.
